
The attached Stipulated Surrender of License and Order is hereby adopted as the Decision and Order of the Medical Board of California, Department of Consumer Affairs, State of California.

20 Complainant alleges:

21 PARTIES

22 1. Kimberly Kirchmeyer (Complainant) brings this Accusation solely in her official
23 capacity as the Executive Director of the Medical Board of California, Department of Consumer
24 Affairs (Board).

25 2. On or about March 23, 1977, the Medical Board issued Physician's and Surgeon's
26 Certificate Number A 30856 to Ingrid Berta Chyba, M.D. (Respondent). The Physician's and
27 Surgeon's Certificate expired on October 31, 2016, and has not been renewed.

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1 JURISDICTION

2 3. This Accusation is brought before the Board, under the authority of the following
3 laws. All section references are to the Business and Professions code unless otherwise indicated.

4 4. Section 118 of the Code states:

5 "(a) The withdrawal of an application for a license after it has been filed with a board in the
6 department shall not, unless the board has consented in writing to such withdrawal, deprive the
7 board of its authority to institute or continue a proceeding against the applicant for the denial of
8 the license upon any ground provided by law or to enter an order denying the license upon any
9 such ground.

10 (b) The suspension, expiration, or forfeiture by operation of law of a license issued by a
11 board in the department, or its suspension, forfeiture, or cancellation by order of the board or by
12 order of a court of law, or its surrender without the written consent of the board, shall not, during
13 any period in which it may be renewed, restored, reissued, or reinstated, deprive the board of its
14 authority to institute or continue a disciplinary proceeding against the licensee upon any ground
15 provided by law or to enter an order suspending or revoking the license or otherwise taking
16 disciplinary action against the licensee on any such ground.

17 (c) As used in this section, board includes an individual who is authorized by any provision
18 of this code to issue, suspend, or revoke a license, and license includes certificate, registration,
19 and permit."

20 5. Section 822 of the Code states:

21 "If a licensing agency determines that its licensee's ability to practice his or her
22 profession safely is impaired because the licensee is mentally ill, or physically ill affecting
23 competency, the licensing agency may take action by any one of the following methods:

24 "(a) Revoking the licensee's certificate or license.

25 "(b) Suspending the licensee's right to practice.

26 "(c) Placing the licensee on probation.

27 "(d) Taking such other action in relation to the licensee as the licensing agency in its
28 discretion deems proper.


1 her power-of-attorney to conduct her affairs. Respondent presently suffers from memory loss that
2 substantially impairs her ability to safely practice medicine.

3 PRAYER

4 WHEREFORE, Complainant requests that a hearing be held on the matters herein alleged,
5 and that following the hearing, the Medical Board of California issue a decision:

- 6 1. Revoking or suspending Physician's and Surgeon's Certificate Number A 30856,
7 issued to Respondent Ingrid Berta Chyba, M.D.;
- 8 2. Revoking, suspending or denying approval of Respondent Ingrid Berta Chyba,
9 M.D.'s authority to supervise physician assistants and advanced practice nurses, pursuant to
10 section 3527 of the Code;
- 11 3. Ordering Respondent Ingrid Berta Chyba, M.D., if placed on probation, to pay the
12 Board the costs of probation monitoring; and
- 13 4. Taking such other and further action as deemed necessary and proper.
