ORDER OF SUSPENSION

9 WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(B) requires the Administrative Director to
10 suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers'
11 compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider who has been suspended, due
12 to fraud or abuse, from the federal Medicare or Medicaid programs; and

13 WHEREAS, Respondent Del Dalton was suspended, due to fraud or abuse, from the
14 federal Medicare or Medicaid programs; and

15 WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(C) requires the Administrative Director to
16 suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers'
17 compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider whose license, certification, or
18 approval to provide health care services has been surrendered or revoked; and

19 WHEREAS, on or about October 17, 2017, Del Dalton's license, certification, or
20 approval to provide health care services was surrendered or revoked by the California Medical
21 Board, Department of Consumer Affairs; and

22 WHEREAS, on or about January 25, 2023, the Administrative Director mailed to Del
23 Dalton a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the procedure to
24 follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California
25 Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1; and

26 WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of
27 Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1(d), the written notice advised Del Dalton that the
28 suspension would start thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice,
 unless Del Dalton submitted a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days

1 of the date of mailing of the notice; and

2 WHEREAS, Del Dalton did not submit a written request for hearing within ten (10)
3 calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

4 WHEREAS, the Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician,
5 practitioner, or provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and California Code of
6 Regulations, title 8, section 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date the notice was mailed,
7 unless the physician, practitioner, or provider submits a written request for a hearing within ten
8 (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice;

9 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Del Dalton is hereby suspended from participating in the
10 workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider.
