ORDER OF SUSPENSION

6 DANIEL DAHAN,

7 Respondent.

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10 WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(B) requires the Administrative Director to
11 suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system
12 as a physician, practitioner, or provider who has been suspended, due to fraud or abuse, from the federal
13 Medicare or Medicaid programs; and

14 WHEREAS, Daniel Dahan was suspended, due to fraud or abuse, from the federal Medicare or
15 Medicaid programs; and

16 WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(C) requires the Administrative Director to
17 suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system
18 as a physician, practitioner, or provider whose license, certification or approval to provide health care
19 services has been surrendered or revoked; and

20 WHEREAS, on or about August 12, 2015, Daniel Dahan's license, certification or approval to
21 provide health care services was surrendered or revoked by the California Department of Consumer
22 Affairs, Board of Chiropractic Examiners;

23 WHEREAS, on or about January 17, 2017, the Administrative Director mailed to Daniel Dahan
24 a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the procedure to follow to request
25 a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations, title 8,
26 section 9788.1; and

27 WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations,
28 title 8, section 9788.1(d) the written notice advised Daniel Dahan that the suspension would start thirty


1 (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice, unless Daniel Dahan submitted a written
2 request for a hearing, within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

3 WHEREAS, Daniel Dahan did not submit a written request for hearing within ten (10) calendar
4 days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

5 WHEREAS, the Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician, practitioner, or
6 provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and Title 8, California Code of Regulations section
7 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date the notice was mailed, unless the physician, practitioner, or
8 provider submits a written request for a hearing, within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of
9 the notice;

10 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Daniel Dahan is hereby suspended from participating in the
11 workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider.
