ORDER OF SUSPENSION

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10 WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) requires the Administrative Director to
11 suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system
12 as a physician, practitioner, or provider if the individual has been convicted of any felony or
13 misdemeanor described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A); and

14 WHEREAS, on or about March 4, 2016, Michael R. Drobot pled guilty to or was found guilty of
15 one or more felonies or misdemeanors described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) in the United
16 States District Court, Central District of California, Southern Division; and

17 WHEREAS, on or about April 14, 2017, the Administrative Director mailed to Michael R.
18 Drobot a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the procedure to follow to
19 request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations,
20 title 8, section 9788.1; and


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22 WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations,
23 title 8, section 9788.1(d), the written notice advised Michael R. Drobot that the suspension would start
24 thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice, unless Michael R. Drobot submitted
25 a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

27 WHEREAS, Michael R. Drobot did not submit a written request for hearing within ten (10)
28 calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

1 WHEREAS, the Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician, practitioner, or
2 provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and Title 8, California Code of Regulations section
3 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date the notice was mailed, unless the physician, practitioner, or
4 provider submits a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of
5 the notice;
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7 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Michael R. Drobot is hereby suspended from participating in
8 the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider.
