GANONG, **ORDER OF SUSPENSION** 7 8 **Respondent.** 9 10 11 WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) requires the Administrative Director 12 to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' 13 compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider if the individual has been 14 convicted of any felony or misdemeanor described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A); 15 and 16 WHEREAS, on or about October 30, 2023, Respondent Philip W. Ganong pled guilty 17 to or was found guilty of one or more felonies or misdemeanors described in Labor Code 18 section 139.21(a)(1)(A) in the Superior Court of California, County of Orange; and 19 WHEREAS, on or about January 16, 2024, the Administrative Director mailed to 20 Philip W. Ganong a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the 21 procedure to follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) 22 and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1; and 23 WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of 24 Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1(d), the written notice advised Philip W. Ganong that the 25 suspension would start thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice, 26 unless Philip W. Ganong submitted a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar 27 days of the date of mailing of the notice; and 28 \parallel

2	(10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

4	practitioner, or provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and California Code of
	Regulations, title 8, section 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date the notice was
5	mailed, unless the physician, practitioner, or provider submits a written request for a
6	hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mail of the notice;
7	IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Respondent Philip W. Ganong is hereby suspended
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9	from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or
10	provider.
