ORDER OF SUSPENSION

JAMES FRANCIS MURPHY,
Respondent.

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WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) requires the Administrative Director to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider if the individual has been convicted of any felony or misdemeanor described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A); and

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WHEREAS, on or about June 20, 2014, James Francis Murphy pled guilty to or was found guilty of one or more felonies or misdemeanors described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) in the United States District Court, Southern District of California; and

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WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(C) requires the Administrative Director to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider whose license, certification or approval to provide health care services has been surrendered or revoked; and

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WHEREAS, on or about October 24, 2016, James Francis Murphy's license, certification or approval to provide health care services was surrendered or revoked by the Osteopathic Medical Board of California, Department of Consumer Affairs; and

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WHEREAS, on or about September 29, 2017, the Administrative Director mailed to James Francis Murphy a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the procedure to follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1; and

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WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1(d), the written notice advised James Francis Murphy that the suspension would


1 start thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice, unless James Francis Murphy
2 submitted a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the
3 notice; and

4 WHEREAS, James Francis Murphy did not submit a written request for hearing within ten (10)
5 calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

6 WHEREAS, the Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician, practitioner, or
7 provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and Title 8, California Code of Regulations section
8 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date the notice was mailed, unless the physician, practitioner, or
9 provider submits a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of
10 the notice;

11 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that James Francis Murphy is hereby suspended from participating
12 in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider.
