ORDER OF SUSPENSION

WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) requires the Administrative Director to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider if the individual has been convicted of any felony or misdemeanor described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A); and

WHEREAS, on or about October 18, 2016, Troy Palmer pled guilty to or was found guilty of one or more felonies or misdemeanors described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) in the Superior Court of California, County of Riverside; and

WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(C) requires the Administrative Director to suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider whose license, certification or approval to provide health care services has been surrendered or revoked; and

WHEREAS, on or about April 4, 2017, Troy Palmer's license, certification or approval to provide health care services was surrendered or revoked by the Osteopathic Medical Board of California, Department of Consumer Affairs; and

WHEREAS, on or about October 6, 2017, the Administrative Director mailed to Troy Palmer a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the procedure to follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1(d), the written notice advised Troy Palmer that the suspension would start

1 thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written notice, unless Troy Palmer submitted a
2 written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

3 WHEREAS, Troy Palmer did not submit a written request for hearing within ten (10) calendar
4 days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

5 WHEREAS, the Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician, practitioner, or
6 provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and Title 8, California Code of Regulations section
7 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date the notice was mailed, unless the physician, practitioner, or
8 provider submits a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of
9 the notice;

10 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Troy Palmer is hereby suspended from participating in the
11 workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider.
