**ORDER OF SUSPENSION**

9 WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) requires the Administrative Director to  
10 suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers'  
11 compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider if the individual has been  
12 convicted of any felony or misdemeanor described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A); and

13 WHEREAS, on or about January 10, 2014, Respondent Antoinette Michelle Williams  
14 (Antoinette Williams) pled guilty to or was found guilty of one or more felonies or  
15 misdemeanors described in Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(A) in the Superior Court of  
16 California, County of Los Angeles; and

17 WHEREAS, Labor Code section 139.21(a)(1)(C) requires the Administrative Director to  
18 suspend any physician, practitioner, or provider from participating in the workers'  
19 compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider whose license, certification or  
20 approval to provide health care services has been surrendered or revoked; and

21 WHEREAS, on or about October 20, 2016, Antoinette Williams's license, certification or  
22 approval to provide health care services was surrendered or revoked by the California Board of  
23 Vocational Nursing and Psychiatric Technicians, Department of Consumer Affairs State of  
24 California; and

25 WHEREAS, on or about December 21, 2022, the Administrative Director mailed to  
26 Antoinette Williams a written notice of the right to a hearing regarding the suspension and the  
27 procedure to follow to request a hearing, as provided in Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and  
28 California Code of Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21(b)(2) and California Code of

1 Regulations, title 8, section 9788.1(d), the written notice advised Antoinette Williams that the  
2 suspension would start thirty (30) calendar days after the date of mailing of written not unless  
3 Antoinette Williams submitted a written request for a hearing within ten (10) calendar days of  
4 the date of mailing of the notice; and

5 WHEREAS, Antoinette Williams did not submit a written request for hearing within ten  
6 (10) calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice; and

7 WHEREAS, the Administrative Director is required to suspend any physician,  
8 practitioner, or provider pursuant to Labor Code section 139.21 and title 8, California Code of  
9 Regulations section 9788.2, after thirty (30) days from the date the notice was mailed, unless  
10 the physician, practitioner, or provider submits a written request for a hearing within ten (10)  
11 calendar days of the date of mailing of the notice;

12 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Antoinette Williams is hereby suspended from  
13 participating in the workers' compensation system as a physician, practitioner, or provider.
