The third shift shall be seven (7) hours of work for eight (8) hours of pay at the non-shift wage rate.

If the prevailing rate is not based on a collectively bargained rate, the holidays upon which the prevailing rate shall be paid shall be as provided in Section 6700 of the Government Code.
