PREDETERMINED INCREASE FOR
LABORER
(CONSTRUCTION-FENCE ERECTOR-GUNITE-HOUSEMOVER)
(SD-23-102-3-2007-1)

IN ALL LOCALITIES WITHIN SAN DIEGO COUNTY

This predetermined increase for the above named craft applies only to the current determination for work being performed on public works projects with bid advertisement dates on or after September 1, 2007, until this determination is superseded by a new determination or a predetermined increase modification notice becomes effective.

When referencing our prevailing wage determinations, please note that if the prevailing wage rate determination which was in effect on the bid advertisement date of a project has a single asterisk (*) after the expiration date, the rate will be good for the life of the project. However, if a prevailing wage rate determination has double asterisks (**) after the expiration date, the rate must be updated on the following date to reflect the predetermined rate change(s).

Laborer: Engineering Construction

Determination SD-23-102-3-2007-1 is currently in effect and expires on June 30, 2008**.

Effective July 1, 2008, the following increases will take effect:

Groups 1-4, there will be an increase of \$2.25 to be allocated as follows: \$1.50 to Basic Hourly Rate, \$0.10 to Health & Welfare, \$0.20 to Pension, \$0.22 to Vacation/Holiday, \$0.01 to Training and \$0.22 to Other Payments.

Group 5, there will be an increase of \$3.00 to be allocated as follows: \$2.25 to Basic Hourly Rate, \$0.10 to Health & Welfare, \$0.20 to Pension, \$0.22 to Vacation/Holiday, \$0.01 to Training and \$0.22 to Other Payments.

Effective July 1, 2009, the following increases took effect: (See Modification Dated July 9, 2009)

Groups 1-4, there was an increase of \$1.25 allocated as follows: \$0.25 to the Basic Hourly Rate, \$0.50 to Health and Welfare and \$0.50 to Pension

Group 5, there was an increase of \$1.50 allocated as follows: \$0.50 to the Basic Hourly Rate, \$0.50 to Health and Welfare and \$0.50 to Pension

Effective July 1, 2010, the following increases will take effect: (See Modification Dated July 9, 2009)

Groups 1-4, there will be an increase of \$1.25 to be allocated as follows: \$1.00 to Health & Welfare and \$0.25 to Pension.

Group 5, there will be an increase of \$1.50 to be allocated as follows: \$0.25 to the Basic Hourly Rate, \$1.00 to Health & Welfare, and \$0.25 to Pension.

Effective July 1, 2011, the following increases will take effect:

Groups 1-4, there will be an increase of \$2.00 to be allocated as follows: \$0.36 to BHR, \$1.00 to Health & Welfare, \$0.50 to Pension, and \$0.14 to Other Payments.

Group 5, there will be an increase of \$3.00 to be allocated as follows: \$1.36 to BHR, \$1.00 to Health & Welfare, \$0.50 to Pension, and \$0.14 to Other Payments.

There will be no further increases applicable to this determination.
