**IMPORTANT NOTICE TO AWARDING BODIES AND OTHER INTERESTED PARTIES
REGARDING MODIFICATIONS OF THE PREDETERMINED INCREASES
IN THE DIRECTOR'S GENERAL PREVAILING WAGE DETERMINATIONS**

Dear Public Official/ Other Interested Parties:

The following are modifications of the predetermined increases effective on December 1, 2010 for the following craft and classifications listed below:

Craft/Classifications: Electrician: Sound & Signal Technician and Soundman (all shifts)

Localities: Imperial and San Diego Counties

Determinations: IMP-2008-2, SDI-2008-2, IMP-2009-1, SDI-2009-1, IMP-2009-2, SDI-2009-2, IMP-2010-1, SDI-2010-1, IMP-2010-2, AND SDI-2010-2

Sound & Signal Technician

- Effective December 1, 2010, the \$0.77 predetermined increase, which was allocated as follows: \$0.75 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.02 to Pension (for NEBF), has been reduced to \$0.75. The new increase of \$0.75 will be allocated as follows: \$0.40 to Health & Welfare and \$0.35 to Pension.
- 2nd Shift – Effective December 1, 2010, the \$0.90 predetermined increase, which was allocated as follows: \$0.88 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.02 to Pension (for NEBF), has been reduced to \$0.75. The new increase of \$0.75 will be allocated as follows: \$0.40 to Health & Welfare and \$0.35 to Pension.
- 3rd Shift - Effective December 1, 2010, the \$1.02 predetermined increase, which was allocated as follows: \$0.99 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.03 to Pension (for NEBF), has been reduced to \$0.75. The new increase of \$0.75 will be allocated as follows: \$0.40 to Health & Welfare and \$0.35 to Pension.

Soundman

- Effective December 1, 2010, the \$0.62 predetermined increase, which was allocated as follows: \$0.60 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.02 to Pension (for NEBF) has been modified. The new increase will be allocated as follows: \$0.62 to wages and or employer payments.
- 2nd Shift – Effective December 1, 2010, the \$0.72 predetermined increase, which was allocated as follows: \$0.70 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.02 to Pension (for NEBF), has been reduced to \$0.68. The new increase of \$0.68 will be allocated as follows: \$0.40 to Health & Welfare and \$0.28 to Pension.
- 3rd Shift - Effective December 1, 2010, the \$0.81 predetermined increase, which was allocated as follows: \$0.79 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.02 to Pension (for NEBF), has been reduced to \$0.68. The new increase of \$0.68 will be allocated as follows: \$0.40 to Health & Welfare and \$0.28 to Pension.

With the exception of the modifications stated above, all of the wage rates, overtime rates, and other conditions found in the above referenced determinations remain in effect.
