2013 – 2019 MASTER LABOR AGREEMENT Office of the Director-Research

Section 1 - Parties To Agreement:

- A. This Agreement entered into this 1st day of July, 2013, by and between signatory members of the Engineering & General Contractors Association, Southern California Contractors Association, San Diego Chapter, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as the Employers), and the Building Material, Construction, Industrial, Professional and Technical Teamsters Local Union No. 36, affiliated with the International Brotherhood of Teamsters, (herein after referred to as the Union).

Section 23 - Parking:

In the event free parking facilities are not available within three hundred and fifty (350)

yards of a job site, the Employer will provide such facilities and shall have the right to designate parking areas to be used. Where, because of congested parking conditions it is necessary to use public facilities, the Employer shall reimburse the employee for the cost of such parking upon being presented with a receipt or voucher certifying to the cost thereof, such reimbursement to be made on a weekly basis or at the conclusion of the project, whichever occurs earlier. Designated parking areas shall be reasonably level and graded to drain.

Section 24 - Transportation:

A. Employees shall travel to and from work on their own time and by means of their own transportation. The employer shall not require, directly or indirectly, an employee covered by the terms of this Agreement to furnish a pickup or other conveyance to transport the Employer's tools, materials or equipment of any kind.

B Subsistence:

Subsistence will be \$30.00 a day. Any work to be done within the Teamsters Local 36 Subsistence Area Map will be entitled to \$30.00 a day. See map enclosed.
