

PREDETERMINED INCREASE

CRAFT/CLASSIFICATIONS:

Tree Trimmer (Line Clearance)

DETERMINATION:

C-TT-61-465-5A-2017-1

LOCALITIES:

All localities within Imperial County

This predetermined increase for the above named craft applies only to the current determination for work being performed on public works projects with bid advertisement dates on or after March 4, 2017, until this determination is superseded by a new determination or a predetermined increase modification notice becomes effective.

When referencing our prevailing wage determinations, please note that if the prevailing wage rate determination which was in effect on the bid advertisement date of a project, has a single asterisk (*) after the expiration date, the rate will be good for the life of the project. However, if a prevailing wage rate determination has double asterisks (**) after the expiration date, the rate must be updated on the following date to reflect the predetermined rate change(s).

Determination C-TT-61-465-5A-2017-1 is currently in effect and expires on July 1, 2017. The following are the predetermined increases.**

TREE TRIMMER: 1st year Climber

Effective July 2, 2017, there will be an increase of \$0.16 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.01 to Vacation & Holiday.

Effective December 31, 2017, there will be an increase of \$0.32 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.02 to Vacation & Holiday.

Effective December 31, 2018, there will be an increase of \$0.37 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.02 to Vacation & Holiday.

TREE TRIMMER: 2nd year Climber

Effective July 2, 2017, there will be an increase of \$0.19 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.02 to Vacation & Holiday.

Effective December 31, 2017, there will be an increase of \$0.38 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.03 to Vacation & Holiday.

Effective December 31, 2018, there will be an increase of \$0.44 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.04 to Vacation & Holiday.

TREE TRIMMER: 3rd year Climber

Effective July 2, 2017, there will be an increase of \$0.21 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.02 to Vacation & Holiday.

Effective December 31, 2017, there will be an increase of \$0.42 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.03 to Vacation & Holiday.

Effective December 31, 2018, there will be an increase of \$0.48 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.04 to Vacation & Holiday.

TREE TRIMMER: Thereafter Climber

Effective July 2, 2017, there will be an increase of \$0.22 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.01 to Vacation & Holiday (Climber after 10 years of service at this level there will be an increase of \$0.22 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.03 to Vacation & Holiday.).

Effective December 31, 2017, there will be an increase of \$0.44 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.04 to Vacation & Holiday (Climber after 10 years of service at this level there will be an increase of \$0.44 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.04 to Vacation & Holiday.).

Effective December 31, 2018, there will be an increase of \$0.50 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.04 to Vacation & Holiday (Climber after 10 years of service at this level there will be an increase of \$0.50 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.05 to Vacation & Holiday.).

TRIMMER TRAINEE: Step 1 (0 – 6 MONTHS)

Effective July 2, 2017, there will be an increase of \$0.13 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.01 to Vacation & Holiday.

Effective December 31, 2017, there will be an increase of \$0.27 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.01 to Vacation & Holiday.

Effective December 31, 2018, there will be an increase of \$0.30 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.01 to Vacation & Holiday.

TRIMMER TRAINEE: Step 2 (7 – 18 MONTHS)

Effective July 2, 2017, there will be an increase of \$0.13 to the Basic Hourly Rate.

Effective December 31, 2017, there will be an increase of \$0.28 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.01 to Vacation & Holiday (Trimmer Trainee after 1 year of service at this level there will be an increase of \$0.28 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.02 to Vacation & Holiday)

Effective December 31, 2018 there will be an increase of \$0.32 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.02 to Vacation & Holiday (Trimmer Trainee after 1 year of service at this level there will be an increase of \$0.32 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.02 to Vacation & Holiday).

GROUNDMAN

Effective July 2, 2017, there will be an increase of \$0.12 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.01 to Vacation & Holiday. (Groundman after 1 year of service at this level will receive an increase of \$0.12 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.01 to Vacation & Holiday; Groundman after 2 years of service at this level will receive an increase of \$0.12 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.01 to Vacation & Holiday; Groundman after 10 years of service at this level will receive an increase of \$0.12 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.01 to Vacation & Holiday).

Effective December 31, 2017, there will be an increase of \$0.25 to the Basic Hourly Rate \$0.01 to Vacation & Holiday (Groundman after 1 year of service at this level will receive an increase of \$0.25 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.02 to Vacation & Holiday; Groundman after 2 years of service at this level will receive an increase of \$0.25 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.02 to Vacation & Holiday; Groundman after 10 years of service at this level will receive an increase of \$0.25 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.02 to Vacation & Holiday).

Effective December 31, 2018, there will be an increase of \$0.29 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.01 to Vacation & Holiday (Groundman after 1 year of service at this level will receive an increase of \$0.29 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.02 to Vacation & Holiday; Groundman after 2 years of service at this level will receive an increase of \$0.29 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.02 to Vacation & Holiday; Groundman after 10 years of service at this level will receive an increase of \$0.29 to the Basic Hourly Rate and \$0.03 to Vacation & Holiday).

There will be no further increases applicable to this determination.
