At the Public Hearing, the Board will consider public testimony on the proposed changes noticed below to occupational safety and health standards in Title 8 of the California Code of Regulations.

NOTICE OF STANDARDS APPROVED

After proceedings held in accordance with and pursuant to authority vested in Sections 142, 142.3 and 142.4 of the Labor Code to implement interpret, or make specific, the Occupational Safety and Health Standards Board, by a majority vote, adopted additions, revisions or deletions to the California Code of Regulations as follows:

1. Title 8, Division 1, Chapter 4, Subchapter 4, Article 3, Section 1512 of the Construction Safety Orders; and Subchapter 5, Group 1, Article 3, Section 2320.10 and Group 2, Article 36, Section 2940.10 of the Electrical Safety Orders, **First Aid for Electrical Workers – Application and Scope.**

Heard at the June 21, 2012, Public Hearing; adopted on July 19, 2012; filed with the Secretary of State on September 5, 2012; and will become effective on October 5, 2012.

2. Title 8, Division 1, Chapter 4, Subchapter 7, Article 109, Section 5189, Appendix A-Mandatory, Section 5192(a)(3), and Section 5198(j)(2)(D)(2) of the General Industry Safety Orders; and Subchapter 4, Section 1532.1(j)(2)(D)(2) of the Construction Safety Orders, **Federal OSHA Amendments and Technical Corrections.**

Heard at the June 21, 2012, Public Hearing; adopted on July 19, 2012; filed with the Secretary of State on September 4, 2012; and will become effective on October 4, 2012.

3. Title 8, Division 1, Chapter 4, Subchapter 7, Article 12, Sections 3420 – 3428 of the General Industry Safety Orders; and Subchapter 5, Article 38, Section 2950 of the High Voltage Electrical Safety Orders, **Tree Work, Maintenance or Removal.**

Heard at the March 15, 2012, Public Hearing; adopted on August 16, 2012; filed with the Secretary of State on September 25, 2012; and will become effective on October 25, 2012.
