## NOTICE OF STANDARDS APPROVED

After proceedings held in accordance with and pursuant to authority vested in Sections 142, 142.3 and 142.4 of the Labor Code to implement, interpret, or make specific, the Occupational Safety and Health Standards Board, by a majority vote, adopted additions, revisions or deletions to the California Code of Regulations, Title 8, Chapter 4, as follows:

1. Title 8, Chapter 4, Subchapter 4, Construction Safety Orders, Article 6, Section 1541, **Excavations, General Requirements.**

Heard at the July 20, 2006, Public Hearing; adopted on January 18, 2007; filed with the Secretary of State on March 1, 2007; and became effective on March 31, 2007.

2. Title 8, Chapter 4, Subchapter 4, Construction Safety Orders, Article 30, Section 1730 and New Section 1731, **Roof Hazards - New Production -Type Residential Construction.**

Heard at the May 18, 2006, Public Hearing; adopted on January 18, 2007; filed with the Secretary of State on March 2, 2007; and became effective on April 1, 2007.

3. Title 8; Chapter 4; Subchapter 4; Construction Safety Orders; Article 4; Sections 1529, 1532, 1532.1 and 1535; Subchapter 7; General Industry Safety Orders; Articles 107, 109 and 110; Sections 5144, 5190, 5198, 5200, 5202, 5207, 5208, 5210, 5211, 5212, 5213, 5214, 5217, 5218 and 5220; and Subchapter 18; Ship Building, Ship Repairing, and Ship Breaking Safety Orders; Article 4; Section 8358; **Assigned Protection Factors for Respirators.**

Heard at the January 18, 2007, Public Hearing; adopted on February 15, 2007; filed with the Secretary of State on March 6, 2007; and became effective on March 6, 2007.

4. Title 8; Chapter 4; Subchapter 7; General Industry Safety Orders; Articles 5 and 6; Sections 3291, 3292, 3295 and 3296; **Load Sustaining Devices Used in Window Cleaning and Building Maintenance Operations.**

Heard at the November 16, 2006, Public Hearing; adopted on February 15, 2007; filed with the Secretary of State on March 27, 2007; and will become effective on April 26, 2007.
