All input will be synthesized into a public summary report to drive future improvements.

**Discussion Topics:**

1. Enhancing Rulemaking Transparency & Digital Channels: Improving communication, website usability, and project tracking dashboards.
2. Stakeholder Representation & Accessibility: Identifying participation barriers and expanding outreach for underrepresented groups.
3. Advisory Committee Optimization: Reviewing selection processes for balanced representation and leveraging hybrid or regional meetings.

4. Streamlining Petitions and Variances: Addressing questions, clarifying processes, and improving submittal and evaluation workflows.
5. Open Forum & General Improvements: An open floor for additional proposals to enhance Board efficacy, efficiency, and fairness.

The Follow-Up Commitment: Closing with a promise to compile and distribute a "Summary of Feedback" report within 30 days.
