**PROPOSED STATE STANDARD,
TITLE 8, DIVISION 1, CHAPTER 4**

Amend Section 1598 to read:

§1598. Traffic Control for Public Streets and Highways.

(a) Where a hazard exists to employees because of traffic or haulage conditions at work sites that encroach upon public streets or highways, a system of traffic controls in conformance with the "California Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, ~~September 26, 2006~~ January 13, 2012," which is herein incorporated by reference and referred to as the "Manual", published by the State Department of Transportation, shall be required so as to abate the hazard.

NOTE: Additional means of traffic control, such as continuous patrol, detours, barricades, or other techniques for the safety of employees may be employed.

PROPOSED STATE STANDARD,

Amend Section 1599 to read:

§1599. Flaggers.

(a) A flagger or flaggers shall be utilized at locations on a construction site where barricades and warning signs cannot control the moving traffic. Unless this section provides differently, the number of flaggers required and matters regarding the deployment of the flagger or flaggers shall be according to the California Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, ~~September 26, 2006~~ January 13, 2012, published by the State Department of Transportation (the Manual), which is herein incorporated by reference.
