Ms. Shupe reported that proposals for Firefighter PPE, Construction Personnel Hoists, and Commercial Diving Operations have been submitted to the Labor Secretary for fiscal review, and proposed decisions for Petitions 575 and 576 are expected at the September meeting.

3. Future Agenda Items

Ms. Burgel asked for an update on the expedited proposal pertaining to Section 1630(a), and **Ms. Shupe** stated that the 36-foot height requirement has been brought into subsection (a) of Section 1630 to alleviate a technical issue. The proposal is currently with the Labor Secretary, and upon being returned with the Secretary Action Request, it will go to the Office of Administrative Law (for public notice). **Ms. Burgel** also asked for an update on the permanent regulation pertaining to protection from wildfire smoke exposure. **Mr. Berg** stated that there is an advisory committee meeting scheduled for August 27. **Ms. Burgel** asked Mr. Berg to provide an update at the September meeting on what happens at that advisory committee meeting.
