PROPOSED STATE STANDARD,
TITLE 8, CHAPTER 4

Amend Section 1671.2(b)(1)(C) to read as follows:

(b) Safety monitoring systems.

(1) The employer shall designate a competent person to monitor the safety of other employees and the employer shall ensure that the safety monitor complies with the following requirements:

(C) ~~Where practicable, the~~ The safety monitor shall be within visual sighting distance of the employee, ~~but~~ and shall always be in communication with the employee being monitored; and,
