- One-stop shop clinics
- No-wrong door policy
  - Cross-Training Staff
  - Data Sharing
- Development of Outreach Assets

## **One Stop Shop Clinic Background**

Build on existing and past outreach efforts:

- CWOP (COVID-19 /California Workplace Outreach Project)
- Labor Rights Caravans
- LCO clinic model in Santa Maria and Central Valley



## Goals

- **Empower** farmworkers, CBOs and advocates with information about worker rights
- **Improve** capacity for the community to use our services and to reach out to us
- Enhance collaboration amongst State Agencies and with local trusted partners



## **Objectives**

- Provide both informational presentations as well as one-on-one consultations to address specific questions and to help workers that have complaints/claims.
- Promote a trauma-informed approach from our staff to encourage farmworkers to exercise their rights and file claims and complaints with us
- Engage and collaborate with farmworker communities that we have not engaged with before or have done limited outreach to.
- Provide a physical presence of LWDA partners to engage with farmworkers.
- Build spaces where staff across agency work together to deliver services to farmworkers



#### **Services**

- The One Stop Shop clinics will offer the following services:
  - Access to all LWDA departments
  - Informational presentations
  - One-on-One assistance and consultation
  - Complaint intake
  - Legal and Interpretation services



#### **Evaluation**

- We will be working with the Possibility Lab to study the impact of the clinics. Possibility Lab will:
  - Research best practices
  - Assist in drafting and adoption of protocols
  - Conduct interviews with grantees and individuals receiving services to assess impact of clinics
- Grantees will be required to work with Possibility Lab



## **Next Steps**

- 1. Applicants will apply to the program
- 2. Grantees are selected
- 3. Meeting between agencies and grantees to draft the protocol for clinics
- 4. Engage with Evaluation Team to identify metrics and study plan
- 5. Confirm physical sites for clinics
- 6. Finalize agenda for clinics and services to be offered
- 7. Launch clinics
