OPINION AND DECISION AFTER
HEARING, AND ORDER SUSPENDING
THE PRIVILEGE OF
JAVIER JIMENEZ TO APPEAR AS A
REPRESENTATIVE OF ANY PARTY
BEFORE THE WCAB
(Appeals Board En Banc)

On December 16, 2015, the Appeals Board issued and served its en banc Notice Of Intention To Suspend The Privilege Of Javier Jimenez To Appear As A Representative Of Any Party Before The WCAB (Notice Of Intention). In the Notice Of Intention, the Appeals Board expressed its intention to suspend the privilege of Javier Jimenez to appear in any proceeding as a representative of any party before the Appeals Board and workers' compensation administrative law judges for one hundred eighty (180) days pursuant to Labor Code section 4907 for the reasons set forth in the Notice Of Intention, which is incorporated by reference herein. Notice was also given in the Notice of Intention that the Appeals Board intended to further order that any suspension continue until there is full compliance with the sanction orders described in the Notice Of Intention.

As part of the Notice Of Intention, Javier Jimenez was provided the opportunity to respond and be heard why his privilege should not be suspended and to obtain further hearing regarding the proposed suspension of his privilege.

No response to the Notice Of Intention and no request for further hearing was received from Mr. Jimenez.

Accordingly, we now issue this Opinion And Decision After Hearing, And Order Suspending The Privilege Of Javier Jimenez To Appear As A Representative Of Any Party Before The WCAB, in which

the privilege of Javier Jimenez of appearing before the WCAB is ordered suspended for one hundred eighty (180) days pursuant to Labor Code Section 4907 for the reasons expressed in the Notice Of Intention and it is further ordered that if there still has not been compliance with the sanction orders described in the Notice of Intention when the one hundred eighty (180) day suspension expires, the suspension of Javier Jimenez shall continue until there has been full compliance with those sanction orders.

For the foregoing reasons,

IT IS ORDERED as the Decision After Hearing of the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board that the privilege of Javier Jimenez to appear in any proceeding as a representative of any party before the Appeals Board or any of its workers' compensation administrative law judges is hereby suspended for one hundred eighty (180) days from the date of this order pursuant to Labor Code section 4907 for the reasons set forth in the December 16, 2015 Notice Of Intention To Suspend The Privilege Of Javier Jimenez To Appear As A Representative Of Any Party Before The WCAB.
