## OPINION AND DECISION AFTER RECONSIDERATION

Lien Claimant Darrell Burstein, M.D., petitioned for reconsideration of the Amended Findings of Fact and Order issued by the workers' compensation administrative law judge (WCJ) in this matter on August 3, 2022 in which the WCJ found lien claimant Dr. Burstein's evaluation and reporting services in the field of internal medicine to have been reasonable and necessary services, but further found such services were not payable due to the failure to submit reporting from Dr. Sobol reviewing and incorporating Dr. Burstein's reports.

Lien claimant contends in its petition for reconsideration that the WCJ erred in finding that lien claimant's services were not payable and requested that the decision be reversed and lien claimant be awarded payment plus costs and interest.

The WCJ issued a report in which she recommended that the lien claimant's petition be denied.

We granted reconsideration to further study the factual and legal issues presented.<sup>1</sup>

Subsequently, the parties participated in a commissioners' settlement conference at our request and agreed to resolve this matter by stipulation. On February 28, 2023, the parties filed a Stipulation to pay Lien Claimant settling the matter for \$6,500.00 as full and final settlement of the dispute. The stipulation, signed by Representatives Marialouisa Lizarraga for lien claimant,

and Megan Dean for defendant, City of Los Angeles, PSI, administered by Sedgwick provides as follows:

Having waived the provisions of Labor Code Sec. 5313, the parties stipulate as follows:

Lien Claimant, Darrell H. Burstein, M.D. retains an outstanding balance of \$12,463.58, not inclusive of potential penalty and interest for the services provided in the above referenced case.

Lien Claimant being represented by Marialouisa Lizarraga, and Defendant being represented by Megan Dean of AM Lien Solutions, agree to resolve the above referenced amount for a total sum of \$6,500.00 as full and final satisfaction of Darrell H. Burstein, M.D.'s Lien in lieu of awaiting a decision from the Appeals Board.

This settlement resolves any and all dates of service for Darrell H. Burstein, M.D. in the case at bar along with all penalty, interests & costs involving the same.

Payment will be made upon receipt of WCAB approval (Order/Award) of these stipulations. P&I waived if paid within 30 days from the Order/Award by the WCAB.

We conclude that the Stipulations filed by lien claimant and defendant is adequate and should be approved.

Finally, we commend the parties for engaging in good faith negotiations and successfully resolving this matter without the need for further litigation.

For the foregoing reasons,

IT IS ORDERED as the Decision After Reconsideration of the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board that the Amended Findings of Fact and Order of the WCJ issued August 3, 2022<sup>2</sup>, be **RESCINDED**.
