### OPINION AND ORDER DISMISSING PETITION FOR REMOVAL

Defendant sought removal in response to the Order closing discovery and continuing the matter to a further mandatory settlement conference (MSC) issued by a workers' compensation administrative law judge (WCJ) on May 3, 2023. Defendant contended that the WCJ should not have closed discovery and should have taken the matter off calendar.

On June 6, 2023, the parties appeared at the MSC. Based on the parties' representation that the case has tentatively resolved, the WCJ continued the matter to a further MSC and did not set a date for trial.
